Spiritual leader and Art of Living Founder, Sri Sri Ravi Shankar, was conferred on Saturday in Dresden, Germany, the “2009 Culture in Balance Award,” in recognition of his outstanding contribution to all facets of culture, and for his commitment to global cultural balance, according to the Art of Living press release from Bangalore.

In granting the award, the selection committee attached special importance to Sri Sri’s efforts in promoting intercultural dialogue, peace and reconciliation in conflict zones, and ethics in business.

The award, instituted by the Forum Tiberius, was presented to Sri Sri by Dresden Mayor, Ms. Helma Orosz, amidst a standing ovation. The award ceremony took place in a special session of the World Culture Forum, at Volkswagen's landmark transparent factory in the eastern German city of Dresden.

The Forum brought together 500 delegates from across Germany and Europe and from all sectors of society, including politicians, religious leaders, CEOs, scientists, professors and media personalities, says the newsletter.
